COPENHAGEN COCO HOTEL

Fusing colourful British-leaning eclecticism with minimalist Nordic aesthetics and French-infused architecture, Coco Hotel offers style in spades. Set in Copenhagen's buzzy Vesterbro area, close to the Tivoli Gardens, it's an ideal place to pitch up and explore the city, with bike rental

organised on site. Set around a courtyard, light-filled rooms marry modern furnishings with vintage pieces – think cane dressers juxtaposed with marble side tables. Owned by Cofoco – a Danish farm-to-table restaurant group – expect a concise menu of seasonal

plates at the ground-floor bistro. Bonus points are afforded to its eco credentials, which sees solar energy generated from their own plot in Jutland, no plastic bottles, and carbon emissions offset by the planting of a tree for every stay. **BG.** Doubles from £177. 00 45 3321 2166, coco-hotel.com

LYLE WASHINGTON DC

Ten blocks from The White House, a similar distance to the Smithsonian, in a residential neighbourhood with plenty of character – and good places to eat – the Forties art deco building that houses the Lyle boutique hotel is perfectly located for a DC city break. A cosmopolitan feel, with book stores, bistros, dive bars, chess in the park, a famed traffic circle and fountain at its epicentre, give the area around the Lyle exactly the right kind of vibe for an American city stay, and when you do return to base camp you couldn't be better looked after. Rooms range

from 23sq m deluxe kings to rooms with kitchenettes, corner suites and the Lyle Suite, which is effectively your own apartment. All of them have a subtle natural-materials decor with a nod to the art deco theme of the building, and the food offering comes with the same welcoming sense of neighbourhood prevailing throughout – the all-day Lyle's Restaurant taking you from your breakfast of blueberry muffins and baked eggs to short ribs and fried chicken in the evening. **AM.** Doubles from £164. 00 1 202 964 6750, lyledc.com
